Dear Jason,

We refer to LRD Pre-Planning Ref: 1069749, in particular – Item 4 Lighting Arrangements.
We confirm that the luminaire(s) proposed do currently demonstrate compliance with the requirements of Limerick City and County Council's Public Lighting Specification, particularly in relation to the provision of appropriate manufacturer / labour warranties and certification.

Specifically it is proposed that new public lighting will be installed and that existing cabling infrastructure will be retained subject to complete testing ON Lady's Lane and Hunts Lane.

We have included a revised Public Lighting Design. The revised design complies fully with Limerick City and County Council's Public Lighting specification and specifically addresses the lighting arrangements for Lady's Lane and Hunts Lane, with wiring only to be retained.

There is a 10 year manufacturer's warranty on the Public Lighting. The electrical installation associated with the Public Lighting will be carried out by a registered electrical contractor and tested and certified by same.

It is proposed to retain the existing public lighting wiring infrastructure subject to the condition, testing and certification of the wiring cabling. This will be carried out by a registered electrical contractor.

We confirm that if the public lighting existing wiring is to be retained that it will meet current specification and warranty requirements.
